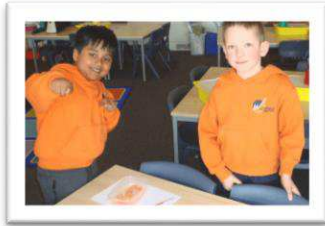


### Feature a Club
