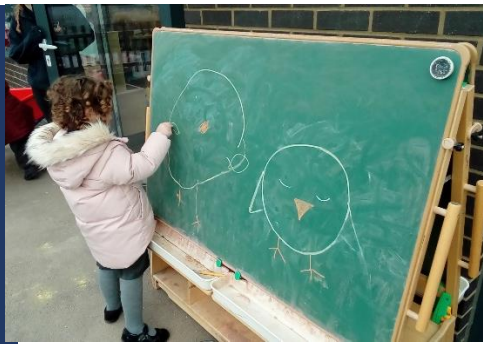


# Nursery News

### Parent workshops

### Uniform and Weather

Please can we remind you all to check and label all of your child's school uniform. This includes sun hats when the weather is warmer. As the sun will soon be making more of an appearance we ask that you ensure your child is wearing sun cream on hot days. Please ensure this has been applied to your child before the school day. We recommend using an 8+ hour protection cream that will protect your child all day. We appreciate however that on hotter days it may be necessary that your child reapply sun cream at midday. For this reason, we ask that you send in a named sun cream for your child that can remain in school. Roller ball sun creams are particularly useful in helping children to be as independent in this as possible. We will of course help your child to apply their sun cream to themselves if they need. Sun hats must be worn on hot days. You may send in a named sun hat that can remain in school if you wish.
