


## Welcome to Whitehouse Primary School

## Carpet Area

This is where we will have our daily check in times, and sit to enjoy stories, singing and rhyme time.





This is where you will hang your coat and bag everyday.

## Creative Area

This is our creative table. This is where we will explore and create by colouring, painting, cutting, sticking and modelling.



## Loose Parts and Construction Area

This is where we will explore by planning, building and balancing using loose parts and fitting together construction materials to create a model, a vehicle or an imaginary scene.



### Small World Area

This is where we will create storylines and retell our favourite tales using characters we know, or by creating imaginary people or creatures living in made up worlds.



### Reading Area

This is our reading arch. This is where we will share stories and look at our favourite books together whilst getting cosy in the cushions.



## Maths Area

This is where we will explore numbers, shapes and patterns.



## Role Play

This is our role play house. This is where we will use our imaginations to take on the role of a character acting out an experience through dressing up, using props and relevant items.



## Sensory Area

This is where we will use our senses to explore. We will use water, sand, slime and many other sensory materials to explore pouring, splashing, filling and emptying using various containers.



## Fine Motor Area

This is where we will develop our fine motor control and skills by threading, stacking, and looping or following patterns and shapes.



## Snack Table

This is where we will enjoy a healthy snack time. We will learn to become more independent by chopping and cutting our fruit; spreading our own butter; opening packets, and pouring a drink into a cup.



## Our Nursery Garden

This is where we explore all of the areas of learning in our outdoor environment. We can cook a soup in the mud kitchen; build an obstacle course with the wooden blocks; explore measures and capacity using water and other sensory materials in the tough tray; and practice our mark making skills using chunky chinks on the playground!
