We enjoyed using the Secret Garden to explore habitats.

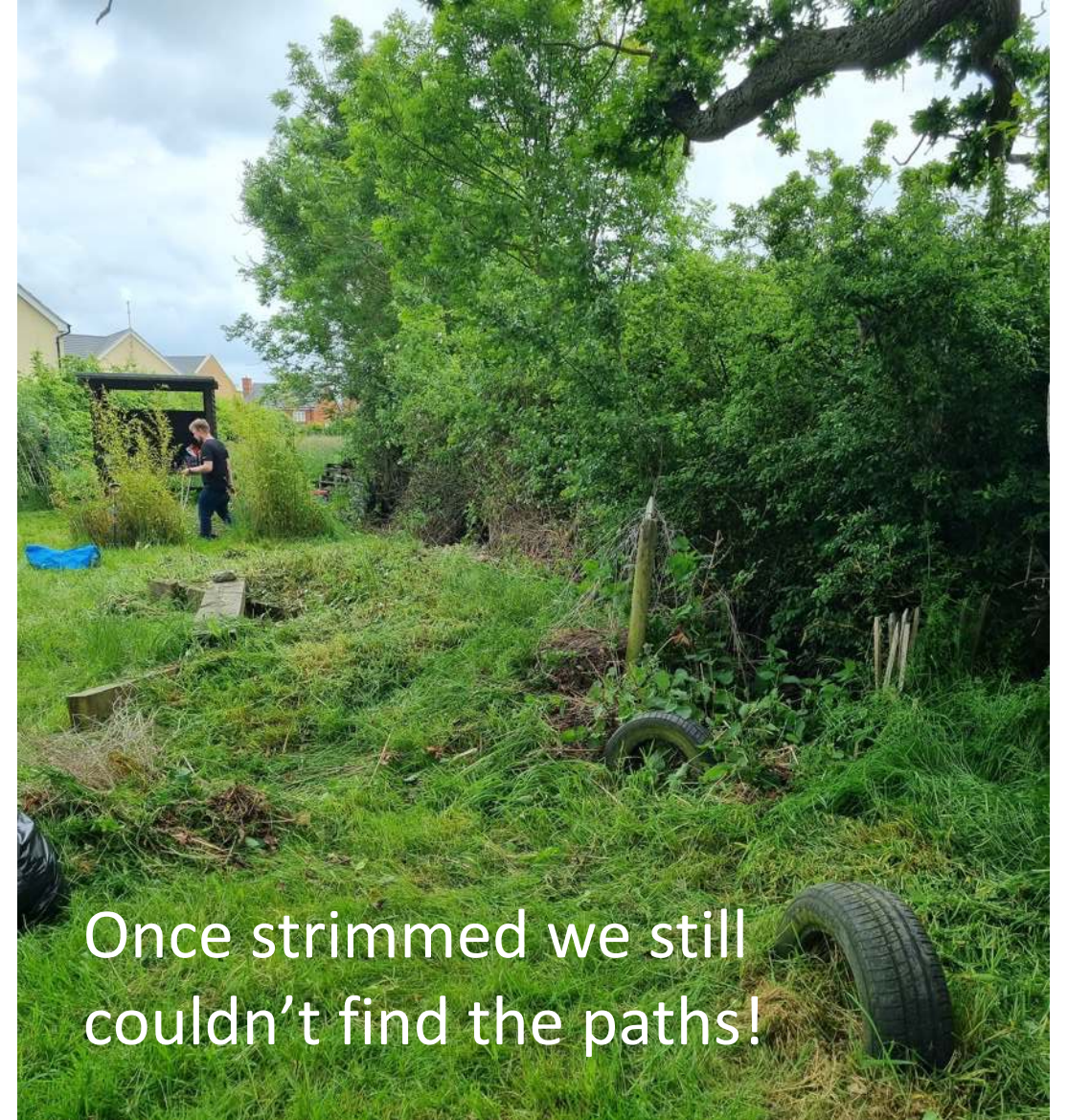




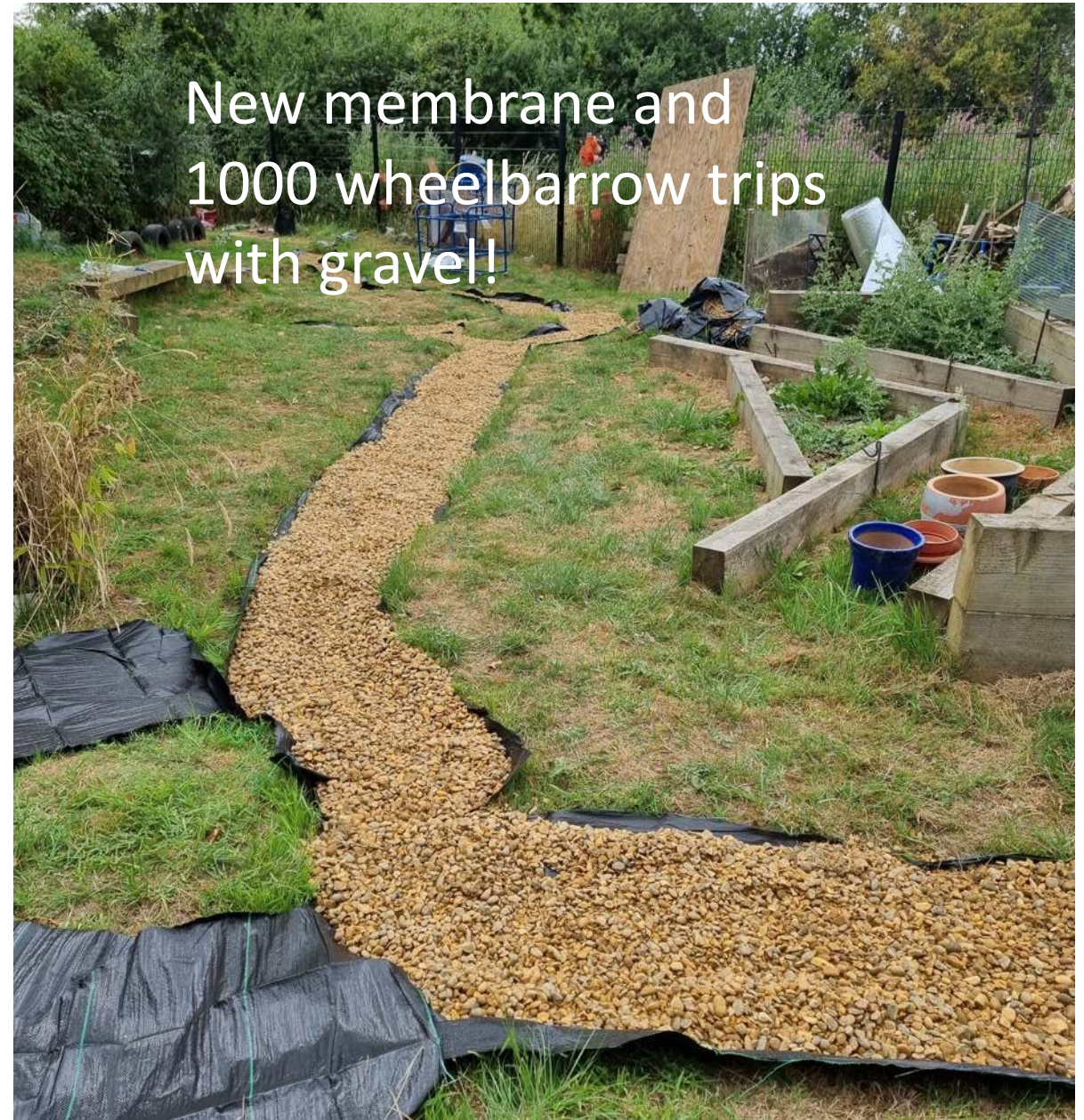
Oh no!..... Over the summer the area had become really overgrown!.
